MAKING ENVELOPES

Two hundred and two envelopes are used to store various kit components. Each envelope has to be taped together and identified with a geometric symbol (sticker) on the front and back. You need scissors and 1 1/2 inch BOOK Tape to make the envelopes.

CONSTRUCTION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Find the component labeled Alphabet Packet Envelopes, Picture Packet Envelopes.
- 2. Place one of these envelopes on a flat surface (with the copyright facing down), and fold on the scored lines.
- 3. Apply tape to the edges on each side of the envelope. Use about one half inch of tape on each side.
- 4. Apply the appropriate stickers to the top edge of the front and back. In this case apply the white triangles. See page 15 below for information regarding which stickers go on which envelopes.
- 5. Put the finished envelope in the Alphabet/Picture Packet box.
- 6. Make another envelope and apply the appropriate stickers. Repeat this process until all the envelopes have been made.
- 7. As each envelope is completed put it in its box.
- 8. The following is a list of the the envelopes to be made:
